## A group for Young People with immigration issues

SLRA and Citizens UK will be hosting six youth participation sessions, every two weeks starting on July 28th.

SLRA in partnership with Coram Children's Legal Centre are running a year long project which will ask local authorities in England to address the nationality and immigration status of all children and young people in care to ensure they have the legal entitlements and security they need as they move into adulthood.

## THE EXPERIENCES AND VOICES OF YOUNG PEOPLE WILL BE AT THE HEART OF THIS PROJECT.

Our aim is to bring youth service users from different organisations together to learn about community organising, leadership skills, how to advocate for their rights and share stories.

We will also look at and explain policies that affect young people in England such as:

- The New immigration policy
- The Care Review

The sessions will also include FUN such as tennis, a picnic and other activites.
